One area where parents can serve their student athletes is by lending a hand with the concession stand. The concession stand is an important part of the sports experience for students. When students aren't actively playing the game, they hang out at the Snack Shack, play, socialize, and watch the other games. Truly, the concession stand is an integral part of the overall atmosphere of the event.

The Warrior Club depends on your active participation and dedication to help make the Snack Shack a success for our students. Listed below are five key points for operating an excellent concession stand. Please note the first two items on the list - staff and service!

**5 Keys to a Winning Concession Stand**

1. Sufficient staff
2. Friendly service
3. Properly cooked food
4. Consistent food
5. Reasonable pricing

There are three different options for working the concession stand. You can sign up to work either before, during, or after your child's team plays. If your team is the first game played that night, you will need to be at the Snack Shack 30 minutes before the game starts. Workers coming in for later games should come in 15 minutes before game time. The 15 minutes cross-over time will give you a chance to acclimate before the earlier workers leave.

This year the Warrior Club is giving parents the option to "Buy Out" from working at the concession stand. If you wish to use this option, the "Buy Out" cost is \$50 per person, per sport.
