Seven Rivers Christian School is a school dedicated to providing a Christ-centered, college-preparatory education for its students. It exists to help you grow spiritually, academically, socially, and physically. In order that we may live together in harmony and united in purpose, there are certain things about SRCS that you should know and understand. First, we teach a worldview based on reformed theology.

We believe that:

1. God is the creator and sustainer of the universe, and the Lord Jesus Christ is the divine Son of God, who came to earth to live a perfect life for us and to die for our sins.
2. God has spoken to us through the Bible, the only infallible Word of God. We must be taught how to study it, understand it, and apply its principles to every part of our daily life.
3. A total personal commitment to Jesus Christ, so that we might live by and believe personally His gospel of grace, allows Him to change us and shape us in a world that is broken.
4. It is God's desire for us to know him and to look at life from His point of view.

Faculty and Staff will seek to:

1. Develop your ability to assume responsibility for the tasks you have been given and for your words and actions.
2. Develop your intellect, for it is given to you by God so that you may take your place in society as a mature, competent, reasonable, and well-trained person.
3. Help you grow as a grateful and responsible citizen and to understand our Western heritage so that you may better understand and appreciate other cultures and peoples of the world.

These are but a few of our hopes and expectations for you. We trust that you will take every occasion to open yourself up to the opportunities offered by SRCS and to live here as a responsible member of the school community.

As a Christian school, Seven Rivers is committed to the teachings of the Bible, and we are persuaded that there should be a direct relationship between what a student believes and how he or she behaves. We acknowledge that it is impossible to create a school community and behavioral standards that are acceptable to every student. We do, however, believe that it is essential to specify certain basic principles that govern all students equally.

Seven Rivers students must commit themselves to:

1. Abstain from involvement with tobacco, illegal drugs, alcohol, sexual immorality, and profane language.
2. Submit, without reservation, to the authority of their parents, teachers, and school officials as given to them by the Lord.

This is a commitment of lifestyle, one that each student makes when voluntarily enrolling in the school. As a student of SRCS, you will be expected to exert a positive influence in your social relationships and to be a responsible member of the school community.
