### COMMUNITY

Citrus County is a rural, residential, small town community located on the west central coast of Florida, 65 to 70 miles north of Tampa. SRCS provides education for several small communities and isolated residential areas representing a population with diverse cultural backgrounds.

### SCHOOL

Seven Rivers Christian School was founded in 1988 as a ministry of Seven Rivers Presbyterian Church to serve the local population of Citrus County. SRCS is a PreK-12 coeducational, college-preparatory school committed to excellence in a full liberal arts program. The enrollment for 2011-2012 is 340 students, with 82 students in the high school and 18 students in the senior class. SRCS graduated its first senior class of seven students in May of 2000.

### ACCREDITATION

SRCS is fully accredited by Christian Schools of Florida and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

### FACULTY

SRCS employs 38 faculty members, 15 of whom hold advanced degrees.

### ADMISSION

Admission to Seven Rivers is selective, and decisions are based on a student's potential to perform satisfactory college-preparatory work. Seven Rivers admits students from all ethnic, racial, cultural, and religious backgrounds. Previous school records, standardized test scores, in-house testing, recommendations, and a personal interview are used for admission purposes.

### COST AND FINANCIAL AID

High school tuition for 2011-2012 is \$7990. 34% of the K-12 student body receives financial assistance.

### GRADING SYSTEM

The high school meets for 180 days each year, divided between two semesters, utilizing an AB block schedule. Each semester concludes with a comprehensive examination that constitutes 20% of the semester grade. Advanced Placement and dual-enrollment classes are weighted an additional one point in calculating a student's GPA, and Honors classes are weighted an additional one-half point. Unweighted grades are reported on the transcript, but the reported GPA is weighted. Courses earn one-half of a Carnegie unit of credit each semester.

Individual class grades are calculated on a 100-point scale, but grade point averages are calculated on a traditional 4.0 scale, computed at the end of each semester. Seven Rivers does **not** report the rank of individual students. Because classes are small, ranking does not provide a fair measure of student performance or ability.
