At the regularly scheduled May board meeting, the SRCS Board amended the approved 2009-2010 academic calendar. The first day for students is Tuesday, August 18, 2009. We recognize that change impacts summer plans and we apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. A new calendar is included with this email and a copy will be mailed with your enrollment confirmation. Reasons for this change include:

- Commitment to dual enrollment courses in the high school as defined by our interagency agreement with CFCC necessitates the change.
- Alignment with the ministry calendar of SRPC.
- Opportunity to conclude the first semester with Christmas Break and end the school year prior to Memorial Day.

We are excited to announce that SRCS will conduct the inaugural spring football practice session this week and practice will continue through the end of the month. Coach Greene and his staff are excited to get the players on the field.
